

Scholarships

Scholarships are available to external applicants currently in Years 2 to Year 5 who will be entering Year 3 to Year 6 in the next academic year. Scholarship Examination assessments are conducted whilst spending a day at Brabyns and are awarded at the discretion of the headteacher to children who are demonstrably in the upper 10% of the ability range nationally.

Academic Scholarships

Academic Scholarships are based on academic achievement and are assessed against Nationally Standardised Tests. Supplementary testing and data may be used, such as phonic screening, reading comprehension, reading accuracy and picture reasoning. Current attainment in English and Maths is assessed using online Progress Tests. Previous school reports will be considered where available, and ongoing teacher assessment against a current class cohort will be conducted during a taster day. For older children, online CAT tests in verbal, quantitative, spatial and non-verbal reasoning may be used. Reading and Spelling age tests may also be administered.

Other Scholarships

A small number of Scholarships are also available for other subjects, notably Sport, Art, Drama and Music. Any outside testimonials will prove very helpful. Your child would also complete various 'tasks' as part of the assessment in their subject/s of strength.

Additional Information

All Awards will be tenable from the date of entry for the duration of your child's time at Brabyns, subject to continued attainment, based upon ongoing assessment at the school. The total amount of any combined Scholarship Award will not exceed 40% for children in Key Stage 2. The percentage awarded for each child is strictly confidential. Scholarships are reviewed annually to ensure that all recipients maintain the effort and attitude required to justify their scholarship.

In cases of proven financial need, awards may be augmented, subject to available funds and completion and submission of a Financial Questionnaire, with supporting evidence.
