English

The children will be taught to punctuate their work with capital letters and full stops, speech marks, commas, exclamation marks and question marks.

We will be continuing our work on the composition of sentences using conjunctions, prepositions, adverbs for time and the perfect form of verbs..

Spelling/Word work will include the following:

'sh' sound spelt 'ch'

Homophones and near homophones

Words from across the curriculum

-gue and -que endings

-sion and -tion endings

's' sound spelt 'c'

Prefixes un-, dis-, mis- and re-

The children will be listening to, discussing, reading and writing a range of text types including:

- Poetry
- Persuasive writing
- Non-fiction

There will be a focus on Comprehension 'Golden rules'.

It is expected that the children will be reading widely and frequently, outside as well as in school, for pleasure and information. They should be able to discuss what they have read.

Mathematics

In Maths the children will cover the following:

- Twice weekly mental maths tests
- Daily times tables practice
- Read, write and convert time between analogue and digital 12- and 24- hour clocks
- Consolidation and enhancement of the 4 operations
- Revision of place value
- Revision of fractions
- Statistics
- Properties of shape
