# Introduction

This document provides a summary of the findings from consultations with children, parents, staff and the Governors at Brabyns Preparatory School.

- Senior School Transfer
- Technology and Online Safety

**Building Relations** – ensuring the School works closely and effectively with everyone

This will include:

- Partners in Academic Success
- Enhancing Parental Understanding and Communication with Parents
- Local Community
- Developing Partnerships within Bellevue Education

**Site and Services** – exploring the way in which the School can use and develop resources to enhance the educational provision and care for families

This will include:

- Wraparound Care
- Nursery Provision
- Site Provision
