<p>Science: <u>Living things and Animals</u> The children will</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Find out about and describe the basic needs of animals for survival. • Notice that animals have offspring which grow into adults. • Identify and compare a range of Animals focusing on farm animals • Compare birds, reptiles, fish and Amphibians • Become familiar with the terms herbivore, carnivore and omnivore 	<p>Religious Education: <u>Our Wonderful World</u> The children will be considering what makes our World special and finding out about the creation story according to Jews, Christians and Muslims. They will also be discussing why it is important to look after our World.</p> <p><u>Christmas Celebrations</u> In the lessons after half term the children will think about different things we celebrate, both religious and non religious. We will then consider the way Christians celebrate Christmas and find out about Christmas traditions around the World</p>	<p>Music & Drama: <i>With specialist Mr Westall</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Find a singing voice • Action songs • Pentatonic songs notes soh-me-la • Rhythms ta, te-te, tiri-tiri • Read rhythms from stick notation • Rehearse and perform Nativity • Mime and act out narrative based on toys.
